

ORDINANCE NO. 349-76

AN ORDINANCE: REGULATING PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO, DURING THE PROCESS OF PLOWING SNOW OFF STREETS AS HEREIN DESCRIBED AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 192-64.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO:

Section 1. Within four hours after two inches of snow has fallen in the Village of Elida, Ohio, no owner, driver or person in charge of any vehicle shall park the same upon the paved portion of any street within the Village of Elida, Ohio, and no such person shall fail to remove forthwith any vehicle parked therein. Failure to remove a vehicle as herein provided shall be deemed a sufficient ground to authorize members of the Village Police Department to cause such vehicle to be impounded at the owner's expense for towing and storage.

Section 2. Upon removal by Village employees of snow from the paved portion of the street, such parking restrictions shall become inoperative with respect to that particular location.

Section 3. Whoever violates Section 1 above shall be deemed guilty of a minor misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and costs.

Section 4. That Ordinance No. 192-64 passed by the Elida Village Council on December 22, 1964, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 5. That the Clerk of the Council be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause publication of this ordinance to be made in a manner as provided for according to law.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
