**AN ORDINANCE: SETTING THE SALARIES TO BE PAID TO ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO, AS HEREIN DESCRIBED.**

**Whereas**, the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized Meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of council, with notice received by all council members; and

**Whereas**, in the usual daily operation of the Village government of the Village of Elida, Ohio, in that it is necessary to set forth the salaries to be paid elected officials of the Village of Elida, OH.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:**

**Section 1.** That salaries be paid elected officials of the Village of Elida, Ohio, effective January 1, 2026 to and including December 31, 2026, as follows:

Mayor	\$7,000.00	Annually
Council	\$2,450.00	Annually
Council President	\$2,800.00	Annually

Salaries for elected employees shall be payable as follows:

Mayor	Equal Monthly Installments
Council	Equally Monthly Installments
Council President	Equally Monthly Installments

**Section 2.** That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed effective January 1, 2026.

**Section 3.** That the Village Fiscal Officer be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause publication of this Ordinance to be made in the manner as provided for according to law.


**Section 4.** that the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio hereby finds that all discussion and debate regarding this matter was conducted in open session of Council pursuant to the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.


**Section 5.** That the Village Fiscal Officer shall, and hereby is, authorized and directed to certify a copy of the Ordinance, immediately after its passage.

**Section 6.** That for the reasons set forth in the preamble, this Ordinance after approval by the Mayor shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law, provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to the Council.
