

ORDINANCE NO. 1251-2026

AN ORDINANCE: OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA,
OHIO SETTING AND REGULATING NOISE
AMPLIFICATION OUTSIDE OF A VEHICLE

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of Council, with notice received by all Council members.

Whereas, it is desirable for the Village of Elida, Ohio to address concerns and issues relating to noise amplification from any motor vehicle.

Whereas, it is desirable that the noise admission coming from any motorized vehicle be regulated so as to keep the peace and welfare of the community.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Elida, by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members elected, approved Ordinance # 1251-2026 read by title on three different days as proscribed by law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO, BY A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:


Section 1. That any vehicle admitting a noise that can be heard by any sworn officer of the law from greater than fifty (50) feet from said vehicle said admission is in violation of said ordinance and subject to a charge of minor misdemeanor.

- a. An exemption exists for any properly registered emergency vehicle.

Section 2. That the maximum fine for said violation shall be one hundred and fifty dollars.


Section 3. That the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio authorizes the Fiscal Officer to make publication and approval from the earliest period prescribed by law.
