Whereas, the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of Council, with notice received by all Council members.

Whereas, it is desirous of the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio to allow said village into a Cooperative Purchase Program.

Whereas, an emergency exists in this regard, that effects the health, safety, or welfare of the public.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Elida, by an affirmative vote of two thirds majority of the members elected, approved Ordinance # 547-2026 read by title, and voted for passage.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDA, OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. That it is hereby declared to be in the public interest that the consent of Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio be, permitted to participate in a cooperative purchasing program regarding the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, and allowing the Administrator and/or Mayor to enter into any agreement regarding the same.

Section 2. The Village of Elida, Ohio hereby permits said agreement finding it to be the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Elida and public at large.


Section 3. The Village Fiscal Officer for the Village of Elida, Ohio is authorized and directed to cause publication of this Resolution to be made in a manner as provided for according to law.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare in the County and for the usual daily operation of the Village of Elida for the reasons set forth and defined in the preamble to this Resolution, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least three fourths the members of this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by this Council or otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 5. That this shall become effective at the earliest prescribed period permitted per law. The clerk shall publish as deemed appropriate.



MODEL RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE State of Ohio COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act. (AM. Sub. H.B. No. 100), as signed into law on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE (LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT)

Section 1. That the (AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT) hereby requests authority in the name of the (LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT) to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to Revised Code Section 125.04.

Section 2. That the (AGENT) is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the (LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT) to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of (LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT) participation in the contract. Further, that the (AGENT) does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to non-members of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04.

Section 3. That the (AGENT) is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the (LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT) to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the (AGENT) does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE MUST BE APPROVED, DATED AND FILED WITH
THE OFFICE OF COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PRIOR TO USE OF A
CONTRACT.

ADDITIONALLY, THE PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE ANNUAL FEE MUST
BE MADE PRIOR TO CONTRACT USE.
