

RESOLUTION NO. 548 - 2026

A RESOLUTION: OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIDIA  
OHIO PERMITTING PURCHASE OF  
EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Elida, Ohio met at a duly called and authorized meeting of the Council, such meeting being duly called pursuant to the rules of Council, with notice received by all Council Members, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Elida is desirous and need of a new backhoe as equipment for the Village.

WHEREAS, the Village of Elida is desirous to purchase a Ohio Cat. 2026 Caterpillar Model 420XE for a price of \$152,570.00. Such price is available by way in part of a trade in of current Village equipment of a 2008 John Deere 310SJ and trade in value of \$25,000.00. Total payment after trade in by the Village will be \$127,570.00.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Village of Elida, Ohio to enter into this approval as an emergency as the sale of equipment is being offered on a first come first serve basis and such matter is time sensitive and in the interest of the public's health, safety or welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY A MINIMUM OF THREE-FOURTH'S VOTING by the Council of the Village of Elida, Ohio:

Section 1. That this Council does hereby authorize the Administrator of the Village of Elida, and/or Mayor to purchase said Ohio Cat. 2026 Caterpillar Model 420XE.

Section 2. That this Council does hereby authorize the purchase of said equipment and the trade in of Village owned John Deere 2008 310SJ making a total purchase price of \$127,570.00 after trade in by the Village of Elida.

Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare in the County and for the usual daily operation of the Village of Elida for the reasons set forth and defined in the preamble to this Resolution, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of at
